April 2010 Breakfast Meeting Thursday, April 15th "NFPA 70E Overview"

Please join us on Thursday, April 15th at Maggiano's in King of Prussia, PA for a breakfast meeting. Our speaker will be Jim Dollard, the Safety Coordinator for the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) Local 98.

Jim will be providing an overview of NFPA 70E: Standard for Electrical Safety in the Workplace. This standard addresses those electrical safety requirements for employee workplaces that are necessary for the practical safeguarding of employees in their pursuit of gainful employment. This standard covers the installation of electric conductors, electric equipment, signaling and communications conductors and equipment, and raceways for the following: (1) Public and private premises, including buildings, structures, mobile homes, recreational vehicles, and floating buildings; (2) Yards, lots, parking lots, carnivals, and industrial substations; (3) Installations of conductors and equipment that connect to the supply of electricity; and (4) Installations used by the electric utility, such as office buildings, warehouses, garages, machine shops, and recreational buildings, that are not an integral part of a generating plant, substation, or control center.

Jim will give an overview of requirements with practical applications; there will be discussion on managing an effective program, as well as Arc Flash and comparing NFPA 70E to the OSHA standard.

Maggiano's Little Italy is located in the southwest corner of the King of Prussia Mall complex, off Mall Blvd.

From PA Turnpike (I-276): Take exit #326 at Valley Forge; follow this road to exit #327 onto N. Gulph Rd. Take a right at the second light onto Goddard Boulevard; follow this road to the mall.

Traveling I-76: Take 76 W towards Valley Forge; take exit #327 onto Mall Boulevard; this puts you directly at the mall.

Traveling Route 202: King of Prussia Mall is located directly off Route 202; turn onto Mall Boulevard to enter the mall.

Traveling Route 422: From 422 E, take First Avenue exit; turn Right onto N. Gulph Road; turn Left onto Goddard Boulevard and follow this road to the mall.

Traveling I-95 (from the South): Follow 95 to 476 N; from 476 N, Take exit #16B onto 76 W; follow 76 W toward Valley Forge to exit #327; this puts you on Mall Boulevard, directly at the mall.

Traveling I-95 (from the North): From 95 S, take Rt. 1 S; take PA Turnpike W; take exit #326 at Valley Forge; follow this road to exit #327 onto N. Gulph Rd.; take a right at the second light onto Goddard Blvd.; follow this road to the mall.

Jim Dollard: IBEW Local 98

Mr. Dollard is the Safety Coordinator for IBEW Local 98. He is also a Master OSHA 500 Instructor and the Chairman of the CMP-10 panel for the National Electric Code.

Mr. Dollard is a Member of the NFPA 70E and NFPA 90A Technical Committees, the UL Electrical Council, and the Mid-Atlantic Construction Safety Council.
